Special Council Meeting July 26th, 2006

I. CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Gibson called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. Members present: Mayor Scott Gibson and Commissioners Terry Marsh, Jason Klenklen, Ed Carmona, Kirk Vernon and Elke Lassiter.

II. POSSIBLE ANNEXATION DISCUSSION

Councilman Ed Carmona informed all in attendance that he will not take part in any discussion of this matter, nor will he vote due to a conflict of interest.

Mayor Gibson requested that a representative from Midwest Management Group introduce the company and present any information to the Council so that they may make an accurate and informed decision regarding the matter of annexing the Brammel Property.

Midwest Management Group founder, Jerry Whitmer, introduced himself and briefed the Council on the history and current situation of Midwest Management Group.

Much discussion regarding the necessary upgrades needed for the new development, as well as standards for the upgrades took place.

The Council recessed into an executive session for the purpose of discussing client-attorney privileges, K.S.A. 75-4319 (b) (2). Motion by Marsh to adjourn to a 5 minute executive session, second by Vernon. The motion passed 4-0. Council adjourned at 7:50. Council reconvened at 7:55.

After several citizens voiced their concerns with the possible development as well as Midwest Management Group, itself, Jerry Whitmer, of Midwest Management Group, informed the Council that it was obvious that the City would not support the development, therefore they would like to withdraw their request. Council accepted.
