Green River Ordinance

In March, the City Council passed what is referred to as the "Green River Ordinance", which prohibits solicitation in the City by all parties except non-profit organizations (the non-profit organizations are still required to obtain a permit from the Ozawkie City Office.) If you notice solicitors in the City or are approached by one, first ask to see a City permit. If one cannot be provided, please note the company and get as much information as possible (i.e. phone number, individual's name, etc.) and contact the City Office.
