Citizen's are welcome to attend the February 11<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting to voice concerns or ask questions regarding the new Water Tower Renovation and Maintenance Agreement that the City entered into at the January Council Meeting. The City has implemented a \$12.86 water surcharge to each customer, per billing period, for the first three years of the project, effective March 1, 2008. After three years, the water surcharge will decrease to \$4.34 per customer, per billing period.
