## Mowing

**Ordinance 8-401:** It shall be unlawful for any owner, agent, lessee, tenant, or other person occupying or having charge or control of any premises to permit weeds to remain upon said premises or any area between the property lines of said premises and the centerline of any adjacent street or alley, including but not specifically limited to sidewalks, streets, alleys, easements, rights-of-way and all other areas, public or private. All weeds as hereinafter defined are hereby declared a nuisance and are subject to abatement as hereinafter provided.

If the grass height is declared a nuisance, the City will send one "reminder to mow" notice to the owner of the property, and allow 10 days for the lot(s) to be mowed. After the notice, if the grass height exceeds 12", the City will mow the lot, without notice, and bill the owner for the mowing. The cost is \$75 per lot, per mow. If the invoice is not paid within 30 days, it will be assessed, through the County Clerk, as a special assessment to the property.
