

**Planning and Zoning
Regular Meeting
May 3rd, 2004**

Ed Carmona called the meeting to order at 7:10pm. Members present: Terry Marsh, Sandi Goetz, Debbie Gaskill, and Ed Carmona.

Motion by Marsh to approve the minutes of the April 5th, 2004 meeting, second by Gaskill, motion carried.

Ed Carmona explained to the Planning & Zoning Committee members the status of the agreement between the Ozawkie Township and the City of Ozawkie for the purchasing of the land, and the possession of the current Township Building. Ed Carmona has been meeting with Mayor Eric Buckman, Fire Chief Jack McNary, and former Fire Chief, Bob Holliday to discuss all of the particulars. Ed Carmona explained that Susan L. Newell, Director of Jefferson County Communications, 911 services for Sheriff, Fire & EMS, has expressed her departments interest in having a 911 facility Communications center in the proposed Township Fire District Facility. The Planning & Zoning committee discussed the pros and cons of the proposed plan.

Terry Marsh and Ed Carmona both believe that there needs to be a public forum for all citizens AND people in the township to come and express their opinions or concerns.
